

Tournament Rules

Batting Rules

- 12 bats per team
- Batters who are out may join the back of their team and carry on playing to ensure everyone gets a decent game
- To score a Rounder you must hit the ball and reach the last base without stopping
- If you hit the ball behind you may only run to 1st base
- You must run on every ball to ensure the game keeps flowing
- Batters must stop running when a base is stumped or the bowler is in possession of the ball

Scoring

- If the batter reaches 4th post without stopping, the batting team scores a Rounder
- If the batter reaches 4th post having previously stopped at a base, ½ rounder scored
- If the batter reaches 4th post without stopping but doesn't hit the ball, ½ rounder scored.

Bowling Rules

- 12 balls per team
- Change of bowler every 6 balls

No balls

- When the ball is above the head/below the knee
- When the ball bounces on it's way to you
- When the ball is wide
- 2 no balls = ½ Rounder to the batting team
- Cannot be caught out on a no ball

A player is out when

- The post the batter is running to is stumped
- You overtake a previous batter on the field
- The batter is caught out by a fielder
